2010 Sailing Instructions

1. RULES

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the *current* Racing Rules of Sailing, US prescriptions, J-24 class rules
- 1.2 Rule 42.3(b) is deleted and replaced by Class Rule 8.2.2.

2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

3. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 3.1 Spring Series 5/19, 26, 6/2, 9, 16, 23, 30
Summer Series 7/7, 14, 21, 28, 8/4, 11, 18, 25, 9/1, 9/8
Fall Series 9/19, 26, 10/3, 10
- 3.2 Warning for the first race: Spring, Summer Series 19:00 Fall Series 13:00
- 3.3 Spring and Summer Series to 8/11: 2 races daily 8/18,25 9/1,9/8 1 race (except for makeup races). Fall Series up to 3 races daily

4. THE COURSE

- 4.1 The courses shall be windward leeward. Weather mark and number of legs will be displayed by RC on course board.

5. MARKS

- 5.1 W Windward Inflatable drop mark .5-1.0 mile to weather of the start line
- T Reach Inflatable drop mark for courses G and O
- A EBYRA Race Mark East of Throggs Neck
- B R "2" Big Tom Flasher
- C RG "CL" Flasher South of Cuban Ledge
- D RN "4" Nun at Big Tom
- E EBYRA Race Mark north of Weir Creek
- R EBYRA Race Mark East of Throggs Neck Bridge Toll Plaza

6. CHECKING IN

- 6.1 Before the warning signal of her first race each day, each boat shall sail past the Race Committee signal boat and hail her sail number until acknowledged by the Race Committee.

7. THE START

- 7.1 The starting line will be between an orange flag on the Race Committee boat and the starting mark.

8. THE FINISH

- 8.1 The finishing line will be between an orange flag on a Race Committee boat and the nearest Mark of the course.

9. TIME LIMIT

- 9.1 If the first boat does not reach Mark 1 within 1/2 hour, or the first boat to finish does not finish within 2 hours, the race shall be abandoned. Boats that fail to finish within 1/2 hour after the first boat finishes will be scored "DID NOT FINISH" (DNF). This modifies rules 35, A3 and A4.1.

10. SAFETY

- 10.1 A boat that retires from a race prior to finishing shall notify the RC before leaving the course area.

11. PENALTIES

- 11.1 RRS 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that, except for infringements of Part 2 that occur within the zone of a rounding mark, only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

12. PROTESTS

- 12.3 Protests shall be written and lodged with the Race Committee or a fleet representative within the Protest Time, which will begin at the time of the last finish of that day and end 1.5 hours later.
- 12.4 Protest notices will be posted on the Official Notice Board at HYC and the website to inform competitors where and when there is a hearing in which they are interested parties.
